Curation of Artifacts for the ePortfolio

What do I need to think about in order to select artifacts?

1. What am I passionate about? This is about you!
2. What artifacts will you curate?
 - a. Things that represent your learnings while you were a WHS Student.
 - b. Consider your personal interests, topics, content, skills, lifestyle, learning, experiences, activities, etc.
3. Connecting this to the artifact to an attribute of the POG

What is an ePortfolio “artifact”?



Artifacts are the documents and media that you include in your ePortfolio. They act as evidence of your skills, experiences, and knowledge. Examples of artifacts include but are not limited to projects, essays, videos, lab reports, photos, Google Sites, etc. You can select artifacts from a range of curricular and co-curricular experiences, such as courses, internships, service work, summer study programs, and leadership positions.

For each artifact, you will need to create a reflection. What is the artifact and why is it meaningful to you and your audience?

How do I connect this to the WPS Portrait of a Graduate (POG)

1. The answer to this question is up to you. You need to THINK and pair the artifact to the POG attribute that makes sense to YOU!
 - a. Don't try to fit an artifact with a POG attribute that does not make sense to you.
 - b. Remember you need to EXPLAIN how the artifact connects to the attribute of the POG in a reflection;
 - c. The explanation of HOW and WHY the artifact fits under the specific attribute needs to be EXPLICITLY stated. Don't make your reader/audience have to guess.
2. Artifacts can connect to many of the POG attributes
